Lk. 7:31-34 Parable of the Brats: This generation - "We played the flute for You, & You did not dance."

7:48-50 Jesus' Verdict for her: (1) Forgiveness & (2) Salvation by Faith - to her: "Your sins have been forgiven." All ask, "WHO is this who forgives sin?!" "Your faith has saved you. Go in peace."
